PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of May 22nd 2022, a total of **18,113,455** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,408,411** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,346,355** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **33,602** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **325,087** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **12,743** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **5,925**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **75** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,248** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.3%**. From the cases **51** are Kenyans while **24** are foreigners. **39** males and **36** females. The youngest is a **6-year-old** while the oldest is **72** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,349** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,653,013**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **59**, Nyeri **12** and Kiambu **4**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(8)**, 20-29 years **(18)**, 30-39 **(18)**, 40-49 **(16)**, 50-59 **(8)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Today, **36** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,360** of whom **265,329** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(410)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,311)**.

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **335** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
