**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of May 24<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,133,142** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,419,411** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,352,862** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **33,760** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **327,109** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **15,486** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,202**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **57** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,954** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.9%**. From the cases **45** are Kenyans while **12** are foreigners. **35** males and **22** females. The youngest is a **5-year-old** while the oldest is **80** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,406** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,655,967**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **37**, Siaya **6**, Kilifi **5**, Kiambu **2**, Murang'a **2**, Kisumu, Kwale, Turkana Mombasa, and Bomet **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(9)**, 20-29 years **(6)**, 30-39 **(16)**, 40-49 **(13)** 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(10)**.

Today, **15** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,375** of whom **265,344** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **4** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **376** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
