**PRESS STATEMENT**

**VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of May 25<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,151,053** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,431,464** are doses

administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,356,122** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **34,011** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **329,456** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **16,083** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **6,704**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

Today **63** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,075** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.0%**. From the cases **56** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **32** males and **31** females. The youngest is a **2-year-old** while the oldest is **74** years old. Total confirmed positive cases

are now **324,469** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,658,042**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **40**, Nyeri **11**, Kiambu **5**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Kakamega **2**, Nakuru **2** and Kisumu **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(4)**, 10-19 years **(5)**, 20-29 years **(16)**, 30-39 **(14)**, 40-49 **(11)** 50-59 **(7)**, 60 years and above **(6)**.

Today, **20** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,395** of whom **265,364** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **3** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **378** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
