**PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **128** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,303** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.6%**. From the cases **104** are Kenyans while **24** are

foreigners. **82** are males and **46** females. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **85** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,686** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,662,979**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nyeri **68**, Nairobi **54**, Kiambu **2**, Kisumu **2**, Kakamega and Siaya **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(6)**, 20-29 years **(63)**, 30-39 **(26)**, 40-49 **(21)** 50-59 **(5)**, 60 years and above **(6)**.

Today, **26** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,446** of whom **265,415** are from the

Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **4** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **523** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of May 27<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,182,995** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,447,936** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,365,818** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **34,226** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **335,015** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **9,875** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **4,712**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **30.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
