PRESS STATEMENT

Today **82** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,197** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.7%**. From the cases **69** are Kenyans while **13** are foreigners. **43** are males and **39** females. The youngest is a **3-**

year-old while the oldest is **88** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **324,768** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,665,176**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **70**, Kiambu **5**, Mombasa **3**, Kakamega **2**, Kilifi and Uasin Gishu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(8)**, 20-29 years **(8)**, 30-39 **(18)**, 40-49 **(15)** 50-59 **(18)**, 60 years and above **(12)**.

Today, **15** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,461** of whom **265,430** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **4** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **586** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
