RE: UPDATED HEALTH MEASURES TO ENTER VARIOUS COUNTRIES

The Ministry has received communication through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, from the Embassies of underlisted countries, informing that their governments have revised, updated and/or instituted eased and new COVID-19 measures for travellers entering their countries as detailed below;

COVID-19 vaccination certificate issued by the Republic of Kenya are accepted and recognized by the Republic of the Philippines for arrival, quarantine protocols and interzonal/ intrazonal movement in the Philippines.b. Persons arriving from Kenya presenting their COVID-19 vaccine certificates shall still be subjected to existing quarantine and testing protocols for fully vaccinated travelers as determined by the Philippines Government from time to time.

As from 20th May 2022 the Government of Israel will remove the following regulations for all passengers arriving in Israel:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. The obligations to perform a COVID-19 test prior to arrival to the State of Israel (by air, land or sea)b. The obligations to perform a COVID-19 test upon the arrival to the State of Israel (by air, land or sea)2. The following obligations will remain in effect for all passengers arriving in the State of Israel:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Prior to arrival in the State of Israel all passengers are required to fill out the health entry statement
