PRESS STATEMENT

Today **150** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,999** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.0%**. From the cases **125** are Kenyans while **25** are foreigners. **84** are females and **66** males. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **85** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **325,320** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,677,527**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **120**, Nakuru **11**, Kiambu **10**, Kilifi **3**, Siaya **2**, Kirinyaga, Kisumu, Kwale and Nyeri **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(8)**, 10-19 years **(10)**, 20-29 years **(24)**, 30-39 **(39)**, 40-49 **(29)** 50-59 **(25)**, 60 years and above **(15)**.

Today, **75** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,698** of whom **265,667** are from the

Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **6** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **965** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 1st 2022, a total of **18,246,738** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,483,746** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,380,761** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **34,766** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **347,465** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **15,561** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **6,829**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
