## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 6, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **80** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,367** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.9%**. From the cases **59** are Kenyans while **21** are foreigners. **42** are females and **38** males. The youngest is a **5-**

**year-old** while the oldest is **84** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **325,634** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,683,499**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **66**, Kiambu **5**, Nakuru **5**, Mombasa and Murang'a **2** cases each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(4)**, 10-19 years **(8)**, 20-29 years **(13)**, 30-39 **(20)**, 40-49 **(19)** 50-59 **(8)**, 60 years and above **(8)**.

Today, **89** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **318,907** of whom **265,876** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **8** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,068** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 5<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,277,404** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,498,295** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,390,380** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **35,280** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **353,449** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **3,449** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **1,246**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
