PRESS STATEMENT

Today **163** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,470** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **6.6%**. From the cases **137** are Kenyans while **26** are foreigners. **86** are males and **77** females. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **87** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **325,797** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,685,969**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **105**, Kiambu **24**, Nakuru **6**, Kitui **5**, Kajiado **4**, Kilifi **4**, Siaya **4**, Nyeri **3**, Embu **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kisumu **2** Uasin Gishu and Busia **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(10)**, 10-19 years **(14)**, 20-29 years **(30)**, 30-39 **(37)**, 40-49 **(34)** 50-59 **(18)**, 60 years and above **(20)**.

Today, **128** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,035** of whom **266,004** are from the

Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **8** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,103** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 6th 2022, a total of **18,300,580** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,510,705** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,396,945** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **35,528** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **357,402** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **18,288** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,829**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
