## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 8, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **218** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,317** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **6.6%**. From the cases **177** are Kenyans while **41** are foreigners. **115** are females and **103** males. The youngest is a **2-**

**year-old** while the oldest is **85** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **326,015** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,689,286**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **160**, Kiambu **19**, Nakuru **11**, Murang'a **10**, Siaya **5**, Kilifi **3**, Kisii **3**, Bungoma **2**, Mombasa **2**, Garissa, Trans Nzoia and Kisumu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(14)**, 10-19 years **(24)**, 20-29 years **(45)**, 30-39 **(54)**, 40-49 **(35)** 50-59 **(23)**, 60 years and above **(23)**.

Today, **82** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,117** of whom **266,086** are from the

Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **8** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,239** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **none** is on supplemental oxygen and **no** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 7<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,329,151** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,524,062** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,407,489** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **35,821** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **361,779** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **23,514** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,776**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
