## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 10, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **232** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,375** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **6.9%**. From the cases **185** are Kenyans while **47** are foreigners. **121** are females and **111** males. The youngest is a **1-**

**year-old** while the oldest is **92** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **326,449** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,695,448**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **123**, Kiambu **29**, Kitui **22**, Nakuru **15**, Uasin Gishu **12**, Kajjado **6**, Kilifi **6**, Mombasa **5**, Siaya **5**, Embu **3**, Kericho **2**, Murang'a **2**, Busia and Kisumu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(11)**, 10-19 years **(26)**, 20-29 years **(49)**, 30-39 **(55)**, 40-49 **(42)** 50-59 **(25)**, 60 years and above **(24)**.

Today, **117** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the

total recoveries to **319,325** of whom **266,294** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **42** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,431** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), while **2** are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 9<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,396,895** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,555,424** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,433,513** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **36,879** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **371,079** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **26,122** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **9,767**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
