PRESS STATEMENT

Today **288** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,696** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **9.9%**. From the cases **229** are Kenyans while **59** are foreigners. **165** are males and **123** females. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **81** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **326,737** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,698,355**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **193**, Kiambu **41**, Nakuru **22**, Mombasa **10**, Murang'a **6**, Kisumu **5**, Uasin Gishu **4**, Kilifi **2**, Kakamega, Laikipia, Meru, Nyeri and Siaya **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(12)**, 10-19 years **(22)**, 20-29 years **(56)**, 30-39 **(83)**, 40-49 **(48)** 50-59 **(50)**, 60 years and above **(17)**.

Today, **94** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,419** of whom **266,388** are from the

Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **45** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,622** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on supplemental oxygen, while **3** in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 10th 2022, a total of **18,432,071** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,571,963** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,446,679** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **37,411** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **376,018** are booster doses.
