PRESS STATEMENT

Today **195** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,549** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **7.7%**. From the cases **170** are Kenyans while **25** are foreigners. **103** are males and **92** females. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **88** years old. Total confirmed positive

cases are now **326,932** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,701,693**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **172**, Kiambu **5**, Uasin Gishu **5**, Mandera **4**, Mombasa **4**, Nyeri **2**, Siaya **2** and Kisumu **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(12)**, 10-19 years **(18)**, 20-29 years **(28)**, 30-39 **(46)**, 40-49 **(42)** 50-59 **(27)**, 60 years and above **(22)**.

Today, **100** patients have recovered from the disease, all of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,519** of whom **266,488** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,031** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **45** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,717** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on supplemental oxygen, while **3** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
