UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 13, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **213** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,147** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **9.9%**. From the cases **142** are Kenyans while **71** are foreigners. **112** are females and **101** males. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **92** years old. Total confirmed positive

cases are now **327,145** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,703,840**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **139**, Kitui **44**, Kilifi **13**, Nyeri **8**, Mombasa **4**, Kiambu **3**, Embu and Siaya **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**12**), 10-19 years (**38**), 20-29 years (**35**), 30-39 (**50**), 40-49 (**35**) 50-59 (**21**), 60 years and above (**22**).

Today, **150** patients have recovered from the disease, **135** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **15** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,669** of whom **266,623** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,046** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **46** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,779** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **5** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on supplemental oxygen, while **3** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 12th 2022, a total of **18,442,246** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,576,598** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,450,149** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **37,541** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **377,958** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **1,858** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **831**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.3%**.

The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
