PRESS STATEMENT

Today **280** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,105** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **9.0%**. From the cases **251** are Kenyans while **29** are foreigners. **150** are males and **130** females. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **90** years old. Total confirmed positive

cases are now **327,425** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,706,945**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **178**, Kiambu **36**, Bungoma **25**, Nakuru **15**, Murang'a **8**, Siaya **7**, Kajiado **4**, Nyandarua **4**, Kericho, Nyeri and Kilifi **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(14)**, 10-19 years **(20)**, 20-29 years **(73)**, 30-39 **(62)**, 40-49 **(45)** 50-59 **(35)**, 60 years and above **(31)**.

Today, **122** patients have recovered from the disease, **117** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **5** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,791** of whom **266,740** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,051** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 **(149)**, 30-39 years **(410)**, 40-49 years **(647)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,311)**.

There are **49** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,934** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on supplemental oxygen, while **4** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
