UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 15, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **467** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,728** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **12.5%**. From the cases **362** are Kenyans while **105** are foreigners. **254** are males and **213** females. The youngest is

a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **88** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **327,892** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,710,673**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **316**, Kiambu **53**, Bungoma **22**, Nakuru **16**, Siaya **16**, Mombasa **14**, Kilifi **6**, Nyeri **5**, Kisumu **3**, Nyamira **3**, Kajiado **2**, Kirinyaga **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Busia, Kitui, Laikipia, Trans Nzoia and Taita Taveta **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(36)**, 10-19 years **(43)**, 20-29 years **(98)**, 30-39 **(127)**, 40-49 **(73)** 50-59 **(50)**, 60 years and above **(40)**.

Today, **112** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **319,903** of whom **266,852** are from the

Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,051** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **49** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **2,289** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on supplemental oxygen, while **4** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 14th 2022, a total of **18,498,777** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,604,882** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,468,375** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **38,537** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **386,983** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **18,926** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,375**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
