## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 17, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **390** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,353** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **11.6%**. From the cases **353** are Kenyans while **37** are foreigners. **202** are females and **188** males. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **101** years old. Total confirmed

positive cases are now **328,709** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,717,333**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **274**, Kiambu **37**, Nakuru **20**, Siaya **10**, Kilifi **9**, Mombasa **8**, Murang'a **8**, Nyeri **7**, Laikipia **4**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Bungoma **2**, Kisumu **2**, Nyamira **2**, Busia, Embu, Meru and Nyandarua **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(25)**, 10-19 years **(31)**, 20-29 years **(75)**, 30-39 **(93)**, 40-49 **(74)** 50-59 **(45)**, 60 years and above **(49)**.

Today, **163** patients have recovered from the disease, **162** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **1** is from a health facility countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **320,146** of whom **267,094** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,052** are from various health facilities nationwide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **52** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **2,860** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on supplemental oxygen, while **7** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 16<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,551,017** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,630,188** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,483,574** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **39,351** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **397,904** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **20,287** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,917**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
