PRESS STATEMENT

Today **398** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,745** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **14.5%**. From the cases **365** are Kenyans while **33** are foreigners. **202** are females and **196** males. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **96** years old. Total confirmed positive

cases are now **329,107** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,720,078**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **237**, Kiambu **46**, Kitui **23**, Murang'a **15**, Uasin Gishu **12**, Mombasa **11**, Kericho **9**, Kilifi **8**, Nakuru **7**, Siaya **6**, Kisumu **4**, Garissa **3**, Kisii **3**, Embu **2**, Kwale **2**, Tana River **2**, Nyeri **2**, Homa Bay, Kajiado, Kakamega, Narok, Meru and Migori **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(19)**, 10-19 years **(41)**, 20-29 years **(89)**, 30-39 **(98)**, 40-49 **(58)** 50-59 **(41)**, 60 years and above **(52)**.

Today, **218** patients have recovered from the disease, **199** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **19** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **320,364** of whom **267,293** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,071** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **70** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,022** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on ventilator support, while **10** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 17th 2022, a total of **18,573,028** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,640,059** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,489,798** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **39,704** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **403,467** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **17,198** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **6,137**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
