## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 22, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **454** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,534** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **12.8%**. From the cases **396** are Kenyans while **58** are foreigners. **231** are females and **223** males. The youngest is a **1-**

**year-old** while the oldest is **86** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **330,478** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,731,699**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **261**, Siaya **32**, Uasin Gishu **27**, Kiambu **24**, Nakuru **22**, Mombasa **17**, Bungoma **16**, Kilifi **14**, Kisumu **6**, Murang'a **6**, Kitui **5**, Kisii **4**, Makueni **3**, Tana River **3**, Nyandarua **3**, Garissa **2**, Kakamega **2**, Kericho **2**, Kwale **2**, Narok **2** and Meru **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(37)**, 10-19 years **(50)**, 20-29 years **(85)**, 30-39 **(125)**, 40-49 **(56)** 50-59 **(57)**, 60 years and above **(44)**.

Today, **195** patients have recovered from the disease, **174** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **21** are

from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **321,281** of whom **268,168** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,113** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **86** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,460** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are all on ventilator support, while **13** are in General Wards and are on

supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
