## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 23, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **559** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,639** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **15.4%**. From the cases **486** are Kenyans while **73** are foreigners. **322** are males and **237** females. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **93** years old. Total confirmed positive

cases are now **331,037** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,735,338**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **253**, Siaya **76**, Kiambu **48**, Nakuru **27**, Nyeri **22**, Kilifi **20**, Kitui **20**, Trans Nzoia **14**, Kericho **13**, Mombasa **12**, Uasin Gishu **11**, Kajiado **8**, Garissa **7**, Kisumu **7**, Meru **4**, Nyamira **4**, Embu **3**, Lamu **3**, Murang'a **2**, Bungoma, Homa Bay, Kirinyaga, Kwale and Laikipia **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(21)**, 10-19 years **(48)**, 20-29 years **(132)**, 30-39 **(135)**, 40-49 **(92)** 50-59 **(55)**, 60 years and above **(76)**.

Today, **213** patients have recovered from the disease, **207** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **6** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **321,494** of whom **268,375** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,119** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **89** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,803** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on ventilator support, while **16** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 22<sup>nd</sup> 2022, a total of **18,668,158** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,688,584** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,510,095** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **41,151** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **428,328** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **23,700** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,998**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
