## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 24, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **502** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,503** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **14.3%**. From the cases **456** are Kenyans while **46** are foreigners. **261** are males and **241** females. The youngest is a **1-year-old** while the oldest is **95** years old. Total confirmed positive

cases are now **331,539** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,738,841**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **286**, Kiambu **37**, Nyeri **31**, Machakos **19**, Murang'a **18**, Siaya **18**, Kilifi **15**, Nakuru **13**, Kericho **11**, Kirinyaga **8**, Kitui **7**, Mombasa **7**, Tana River **7**, Kajiado **5**, Garissa **4**, Nyandarua **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Kakamega **2**, Kisii **2**, Kisumu **2**, Bungoma, Busia, Taita Taveta and West Pokot **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(27)**, 10-19 years **(40)**, 20-29 years **(109)**, 30-39 **(139)**, 40-49 **(91)** 50-59 **(45)**, 60 years and above **(51)**.

Today, **280** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** of them from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the

total recoveries to **321,774** of whom **268,655** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,119** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **99** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,513** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and are on ventilator support, while **16** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2022, a total of **18,696,980** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,702,410** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,514,784** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **41,395** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **438,391** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **23,536** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,779**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
