UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 25, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **427** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,291** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **13%**. From the cases **365** are Kenyans while **62** are foreigners. **217** are males and **210** females. The youngest is a **2-year-old** while the oldest is **100** years old. Total confirmed

positive cases are now **331,966** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,742,132**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **259**, Kiambu **36**, Siaya **24**, Mombasa **15**, Nakuru **15**, Kilifi **13**, Kirinyaga **13**, Kericho **12**, Uasin Gishu **12**, Kisumu **7**, Garissa **4**, Laikipia **4**, Nyandarua **4**, Kitui **2**, Homa Bay, Kakamega, Kisii, Lamu, Machakos, Meru and Taita Taveta **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(16)**, 10-19 years **(63)**, 20-29 years **(73)**, 30-39 **(110)**, 40-49 **(69)** 50-59 **(55)**, 60 years and above **(41)**.

Today, **467** patients have recovered from the disease, **454** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **13** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **322,241** of whom **269,109** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,132** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **109** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,965** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of whom **2** are on ventilator support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **15** are in the General Wards and are all on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 24th 2022, a total of **18,717,774** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,712,599** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,518,183** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **41,603** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **445,389** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **16,722** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **6,357**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
