PRESS STATEMENT

Today **261** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,697** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **9.7%**. From the cases **220** are Kenyans while **41** are foreigners. **134** are males and **127** females. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **94** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **332,227** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,744,829**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **155**, Kiambu **31**, Laikipia **24**, Garissa **7**, Machakos **6**, Tana River **6**, Kajiado **5**, Mombasa **5**, Busia **4**, Nakuru **4**, Kisumu **3**, Siaya **3**, Meru **3**, Bungoma **2**, Embu, Kakamega and Kilifi **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(6)**, 10-19 years **(11)**, 20-29 years **(41)**, 30-39 **(86)**, 40-49 **(49)** 50-59 **(43)**, 60 years and above **(25)**.

Today, **426** patients have recovered from the disease, **406** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **20** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **322,667** of whom **269,515** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,152** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **1** patient has succumbed to the disease, and it is a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of June 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,652**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,312**).

There are **118** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,790** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care

program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of whom **3** are on ventilator support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **18** are in the General Wards and are all on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
