PRESS STATEMENT

Today **232** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,030** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **11.4%**. From the cases **210** are Kenyans while **22** are foreigners. **117** are males and **115** females. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **96** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **332,459** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,746,859**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **146**, Murang'a **27**, Nyeri **22**, Uasin Gishu **9**, Kilifi **7**, Siaya **5**, Machakos **4**, Kajiado **3**, Laikipia **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kakamega, Kiambu, Nakuru, Narok and Tana River **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(17)**, 10-19 years **(17)**, 20-29 years **(40)**, 30-39 **(55)**, 40-49 **(43)** 50-59 **(25)**, 60 years and above **(35)**.

Today, **390** patients have recovered from the disease, **367** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **23** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **323,057** of whom **269,882** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,175** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,652**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,312**).

There are **110** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,640** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of whom **3** are on ventilator support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen.

Another **13** are in the General Wards and are all on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 26th 2022, a total of **18,736,222** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,721,046** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

Another **1,522,824** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **41,877** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **450,475** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,963** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **2,194**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
