PRESS STATEMENT

Today **439** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,937** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **11.2%**. From the cases **398** are Kenyans while **41** are foreigners. **237** are females and **202** males. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **88** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **332,898** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,750,796**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **198**, Kitui **42**, Nakuru **27**, Kiambu **26**, Siaya **26**, Murang'a **15**, Garissa **14**, Bomet **9**, Nyeri **9**, Tana River **9**, Laikipia **7**, Makueni **7**, Kilifi **6**, Nyamira **6**, Nyandarua **5**, Narok **5**, Uasin Gishu **5**, Samburu **4**, Busia **3**, Mombasa **3**, Baringo **2**, Kisumu **2**, Machakos **2**, West Pokot **2**, Embu, Homa Bay, Kajiado, Kirinyaga and Kwale **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(17)**, 10-19 years **(42)**, 20-29 years **(113)**, 30-39 **(91)**, 40-49 **(79)** 50-59 **(49)**, 60 years and above **(48)**.

Today, **398** patients have recovered from the disease, **384** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **14** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **323,455** of whom **270,266** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,189** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,652**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,312**).

There are **122** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,669** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **5** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of whom

4 are on ventilator support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **16** are in the General Wards and are all on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of June 27th 2022, a total of **18,759,670** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,733,408** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,526,764** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **42,113** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **457,385** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **18,605** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,610**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was

31.7%. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
