## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 20, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **252** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,993** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **12.6%**. From the cases **228** are Kenyans while **24** are foreigners. **132** are males and **120** females. The youngest is a **1-**

**year-old** while the oldest is **87** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **329,605** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,724,555**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **195**, Kilifi **14**, Kiambu **12**, Mombasa **5**, Siaya **5**, Nyeri **4**, Nakuru **4**, Nyamira **4**, Uasin Gishu **4**, Murang'a **2**, Kitui **2**, and Tana River **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**13**), 10-19 years (**23**), 20-29 years (**36**), 30-39 (**67**), 40-49 (**47**) 50-59 (**28**), 60 years and above (**38**).

Today, **232** patients have recovered from the disease, **223** are from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **9** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **320,566** of whom **267,714** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,084** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,651**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,311**).

There are **75** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,081** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on ventilator support, while **11** are in General Wards and are on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 19<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,589,484** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,647,255** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,495,936** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **40,251** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **406,042** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **3,674** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **1,194**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
