## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JULY 4, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **108** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,366** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **7.9%**. From the cases **96** are Kenyans while **12** are foreigners. **59** are males and **49** females. The youngest is a **2-**

**month-old** while the oldest is **116** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **334,551** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,766,986**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **70**, Baringo **6**, Kiambu **5**, Nyeri **5**, Uasin Gishu **5**, Tana River **3**, Kitui **2**, Machakos **2**, Mombasa **2**, Siaya **2**, Homa Bay, Kericho, Laikipia, Murang'a, Nyandarua and Kajiado **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(4)**, 10-19 years **(7)**, 20-29 years **(16)**, 30-39 **(24)**, 40-49 **(17)** 50-59 **(15)**, 60 years and above **(25)**.

Today, **53** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **325,438** of whom **272,186** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,252** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,656**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,314**).

There are **126** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,331** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **4** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **22** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2022, a total of **18,872,834** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,793,389** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,548,338** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **43,429** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **487,678** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **4,443** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **2,248**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
