PRESS STATEMENT

Today **228** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,471** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **9.2%**. From the cases **204** are Kenyans while **24** are foreigners. **121** are males and **107** females. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **93** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **335,569** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,777,444**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **98**, Siaya **36**, Embu **11**, Kiambu **11**, Busia **10**, Kitui **8**, Machakos **8**, Uasin Gishu **8**, Mombasa **7**, Kirinyaga **6**, Kakamega **4**, Kilifi **4**, Kisumu **3**, Nyandarua **3**, Meru **2**, Nakuru **2**, Nyeri **2**, Taita Taveta **2**, Kisii, Murang'a and West Pokot **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(12)**, 10-19 years **(15)**, 20-29 years **(52)**, 30-39 **(51)**, 40-49 **(48)** 50-59 **(18)**, 60 years and above **(32)**.

Today, **20** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total

recoveries to **326,819** of whom **273,511** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,308** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,660**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**649**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,316**).

There are **155** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **2,727** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **13** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 7th 2022, a total of **18,955,324** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,839,951** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,555,639** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **44,018** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **515,716** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **20,227** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,842**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
