UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 10, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **88** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,615** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.4%**. From the cases **74** are Kenyans while **14** are foreigners. **50** are females and **38** males. The youngest is a **1-**

year-old while the oldest is **85** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **335,861** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,781,431**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **60**, West Pokot **17**, Mombasa **4**, Kiambu **3**, Nyeri **2**, Bungoma and Machakos **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(9)**, 20-29 years **(21)**, 30-39 **(19)**, 40-49 **(12)** 50-59 **(12)**, 60 years and above **(13)**.

Today, **400** patients have recovered from the disease, **388** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **12** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **328,027** of whom **274,704** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,323** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **4** patients have succumbed to the disease, which are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of July 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,667**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**651**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **146** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **2,025** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **11** are in the General

Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 9th 2022, a total of **18,982,295** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,854,971** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,558,176** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **44,181** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **524,967** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **5,478** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **2,637**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
