PRESS STATEMENT

Today **68** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,637** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **4.2%**. From the cases **61** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **34** are males while **34** are females. The youngest is a

4-month-old while the oldest is **94** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **335,929** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,783,068**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **39**, Kiambu **8**, Makueni **6**, Siaya **6**, Kakamega **2**, Nakuru **2**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Kericho, Mandera and Mombasa **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(22)**, 30-39 **(16)**, 40-49 **(12)** 50-59 **(8)**, 60 years and above **(8)**.

Today, **257** patients have recovered from the disease, **237** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **20** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **328,284** of whom **274,941** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,343** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **1** patient has succumbed to the disease, which is a late death reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of June 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,668**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **120** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,857** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of

whom are on ventilatory support. Another **11** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
