## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JULY 13, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **239** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,413** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **9.9%**. From the cases **212** are Kenyans while **27** are foreigners. **157** are males while **82** are females. The youngest is

a **5-month-old** while the oldest is **93** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **336,292** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,787,541**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **98**, Bungoma **69**, Siaya **16**, Uasin Gishu **11**, Kiambu **8**, Busia **7**, Nakuru **5**, Nyamira **5**, Tana River **5**, Laikipia **4**, Nyandarua **4**, Kajiado **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kakamega, Kirinyaga and Machakos **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(13)**, 10-19 years **(17)**, 20-29 years **(64)**, 30-39 **(52)**, 40-49 **(46)** 50-59 **(16)**, 60 years and above **(31)**.

Today, **258** patients have recovered from the disease, **255** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **3** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **328,825** of whom **275,471** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,354** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,668**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **143** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,656** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **11** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of July 12<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **19,014,270** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,874,043** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,560,841** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **44,324** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **535,062** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **16,115** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,404**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
