UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **153** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,769** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.5%**. From the cases **131** are Kenyans while **22** are foreigners. **79** are females while **74** are males. The youngest is a

2-month-old while the oldest is **110** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **336,445** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,790,310**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **70**, Siaya **23**, Kilifi **17**, Uasin Gishu **11**, Kericho **8**, Kiambu **5**, Kisumu **4**, Kitui **4**, Murang'a **4**, Baringo, Kajiado, Kisii, Kwale, Nakuru, Nyeri and West Pokot **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(22)**, 10-19 years **(12)**, 20-29 years **(33)**, 30-39 **(42)**, 40-49 **(18)** 50-59 **(15)**, 60 years and above **(11)**.

Today, **297** patients have recovered from the disease, **268** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **29** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **329,122** of whom **275,739** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,383** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,668**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **127** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,528** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **10** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 13th 2022, a total of **19,038,449** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,887,818** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,563,036** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **44,613** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **542,982** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **19,405** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,301**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
