UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 16, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **112** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,224** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.0%**. From the cases **106** are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **68** are males while **44** are females. The youngest is a

1-year-old while the oldest is **101** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **336,690** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,795,060**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **52**, Trans Nzoia **21**, Uasin Gishu **8**, Kiambu **6**, Kilifi **5**, Siaya **4**, Kericho **3**, Kirinyaga **3**, Mombasa **2**, Nakuru **2**, Busia, Homa Bay, Kisumu, Machakos, Narok and Nyeri **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(6)**, 10-19 years **(9)**, 20-29 years **(23)**, 30-39 **(26)**, 40-49 **(19)** 50-59 **(10)**, 60 years and above **(19)**.

Today, **108** patients have recovered from the disease, **99** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **9** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to

329,424 of whom **276,028** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,396** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,668**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(150)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,029)**, 60 years and above **(3,320)**.

There are **124** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,474** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **10** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 15th 2022, a total of **19,072,302** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,906,091** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,566,423** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **44,902** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **554,886** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **13,603** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **5,352**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
