PRESS STATEMENT

Today **50** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,160** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **4.3%**. From the cases **42** are Kenyans while **8** are foreigners. **28** are males while **22** are females. The youngest is a

2-year-old while the oldest is **79** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **336,740** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,796,220**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **32**, Kericho **5**, Garissa **3**, Makueni **3**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Mombasa **2**, Embu and Kiambu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(18)**, 40-49 **(8)** 50-59 **(5)**, 60 years and above **(12)**.

Today, **249** patients have recovered from the disease, **212** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **37** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **329,673** of whom **276,240** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,433** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,668**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **93** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,306** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), all of whom are on ventilatory support. Another **6** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 16th 2022, a total of **19,083,187** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,912,025** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,567,688** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **45,083** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **558,391** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **8,883** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **3,884**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
