## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JULY 18, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **58** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,511** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.8%**. From the cases **51** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **32** are males while **26** are females. The oldest is **93**

years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **336,798** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,797,731**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **33**, Nyeri **13**, Baringo **4**, Machakos **3**, Uasin Gishu **2**, Kericho, Nakuru and Siaya **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(7)**, 10-19 years **(5)**, 20-29 years **(11)**, 30-39 **(11)**, 40-49 **(4)** 50-59 **(6)**, 60 years and above **(14)**.

Today, **228** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **329,901** of whom **276,468** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,433** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,668**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **93** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,136** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **1** on ventilatory support while the other is on supplemental oxygen. Another **6** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of July 17<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **19,093,750** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,917,411** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,568,659** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **45,232** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **562,448** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **8,438** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **3,278**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
