PRESS STATEMENT

Today **106** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,057** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **5.2%**. From the cases **95** are Kenyans while **11** are foreigners. **56** are males while **50** are females. The youngest is a

3-month-old while the oldest is **97** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **336,904** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,799,788**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **61**, Kilifi **11**, Siaya **10**, Meru **7**, Narok **4**, Kiambu **3**, Homa Bay **2**, Mombasa **2**, Nakuru **2**, Kajiado, Kitui, Laikipia and Murang'a **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(13)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(21)**, 30-39 **(21)**, 40-49 **(18)** 50-59 **(15)**, 60 years and above **(14)**.

Today, **204** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **330,105** of whom **276,672** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,433** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,668**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **93** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,038** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **2** on ventilatory support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **6** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 18th 2022, a total of **19,116,765** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,930,163** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,570,839** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **45,916** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **569,847** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **18,114** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **7,440**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
