PRESS STATEMENT

Today **101** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **2,222** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **4.5%**. From the cases **85** are Kenyans while **16** are foreigners. **51** are males while **50** are females. The youngest is a

1-year-old while the oldest is **94** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,005** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,802,010**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **57**, Siaya **11**, Kilifi **7**, Kiambu **6**, Mombasa **6**, Kisumu **5**, Garissa **3**, Kericho **2**, Kirinyaga **2**, Embu and Machakos **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(10)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(14)**, 30-39 **(21)**, 40-49 **(26)** 50-59 **(13)**, 6/0 years and above **(16)**.

Today, **88** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **330,193** of whom **276,760** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,433** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **2** patients have succumbed to the disease, **all** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of June 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,670**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **94** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **1,048** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **3** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **2** on ventilatory support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **7**

are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 19th 2022, a total of **19,148,223** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,944,531** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,575,736** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **48,415** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **579,541** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **27,236** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **9,464**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
