PRESS STATEMENT

Today **76** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,680** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **4.5%**. From the cases **70** are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **44** are males while **32** are females. The youngest is a

4-month-old while the oldest is **84** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,161** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,805,765**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **44**, Samburu **9**, Tana River **9**, Siaya **2**, Kajiado **2**, Kericho **2**, Baringo, Bungoma, Homa Bay, Kakamega, Kiambu, Kitui, Mombasa and Taita Taveta **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(7)**, 10-19 years **(5)**, 20-29 years **(19)**, 30-39 **(18)**, 40-49 **(12)** 50-59 **(8)**, 60 years and above **(7)**.

Today, **124** patients have recovered from the disease, **112** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **12** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total

recoveries to **330,385** of whom **276,938** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,447** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,670**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **134** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **972** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **5** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **4** on ventilatory support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **24** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 21st 2022, a total of **19,216,316** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,974,030** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,589,258** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **56,429** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **596,599** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **26,342** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,974**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
