## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JULY 24, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **55** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,934** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.8%**. From the cases **45** are Kenyans while **10** are foreigners. **36** are males while **19** are females. The youngest is a

**2-year-old** while the oldest is **88** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,297** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,809,076**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **39**, Uasin Gishu **6**, Murang'a **4**, Busia **2**, Mombasa **2**, Kiambu and Kisumu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(5)**, 30-39 **(17)**, 40-49 **(7)** 50-59 **(10)**, 60 years and above **(9)**.

Today, **153** patients have recovered from the disease, **152** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **1** is from a health facility countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **330,777** of whom **277,249** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,528** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,670**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **53** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **797** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and is on ventilatory support. Another **11** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of July 23<sup>rd</sup> 2022, a total of **19,399,459** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,050,891** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,615,644** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **75,224** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **657,700** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **85,085** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **32,450**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **32.6%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
