PRESS STATEMENT

Today **42** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,564** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.7%**. From the cases **37** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **24** are males while **18** are females. The youngest is a **6-year-old** while the

oldest is **95** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,339** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,810,640**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **25**, Nyeri **6**, Mandera **4**, Siaya **3**, Kakamega, Machakos, Narok and Tharaka Nithi **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(4)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(8)**, 40-49 **(5)** 50-59 **(9)**, 60 years and above **(12)**.

Today, **133** patients have recovered from the disease, **130** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **3** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **330,910** of whom **277,379** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,531** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,670**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**150**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,320**).

There are **51** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **708** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. There is **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU. Another **11** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).
