UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 26, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **50** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,869** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.7%**. From the cases **43** are Kenyans while **7** are foreigners. **26** are females while **24** are males. The youngest is a

2-year-old while the oldest is **82** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,389** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,812,509**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **23**, Trans Nzoia **7**, Kilifi **5**, Siaya **3**, Garissa **2**, Kirinyaga **2**, Machakos **2**, Embu, Isiolo, Kisumu, Kitui, Laikipia and Mombasa **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(7)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(10)**, 30-39 **(9)**, 40-49 **(10)** 50-59 **(7)**, 60 years and above **(6)**.

Today, **110** patients have recovered from the disease, **108** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **2** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,020** of whom **277,487** are from the Home-

Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,533** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Sadly, **2** patients have succumbed to the disease, and **all** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the month of July 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,672**. Our sincere condolences to the families and friends that have lost their loved ones.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **50** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **647** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. There is **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU).

Another **8** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 25th 2022, a total of **19,658,988** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,158,509** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,651,984** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **101,456** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **747,039** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **127,509** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **40,686**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **33.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
