### **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 27, 2022**

#### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **67** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,924** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **3.5%**. From the cases, **55** are Kenyans while **12** are foreigners. **36** are males while **31** are females. The youngest is a

**1-year-old** while the oldest is **98** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,456** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,814,433**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **34**, Uasin Gishu **12**, Kilifi **5**, Meru **4**, Siaya **4**, Isiolo **2**, Kiambu **2**, Kisumu **2**, Kericho and Kwale **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(9)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(13)**, 30-39 **(16)**, 40-49 **(7)** 50-59 **(13)**, 60 years and above **(7)**.

Today, **50** patients have recovered from the disease, **48** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **2** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,070** of whom **277,535** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,535** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **53** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **661** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on ventilatory support. Another **5** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of July 26<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **19,826,245** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,221,309** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,683,647** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **129,797** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **791,492** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **140,731** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **41,469**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **33.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
