## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT JUNE 30, 2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today **404** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,075** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **13.1%**. From the cases **335** are Kenyans while **69** are foreigners. **179** are females and **225** males. The youngest is a **1-**

**year-old** while the oldest is **102** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **333,694** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,756,995**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **220**, Siaya **37**, Kericho **20**, Kilifi **14**, Nakuru **14**, Murang'a **13**, Kajiado **12**, Kakamega **12**, Mombasa **11**, Embu **9**, Kiambu **9**, Kitui **8**, Kisumu **7**, Kirinyaga **5**, Makueni **3**, Laikipia **2**, Nyeri **2**, Garissa, Homa Bay, Machakos, Meru, Nyamira and Nyandarua **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(16)**, 10-19 years **(28)**, 20-29 years **(99)**, 30-39 **(103)**, 40-49 **(67)** 50-59 **(38)**, 60 years and above **(53)**.

Today, **252** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total

recoveries to **323,953** of whom **270,748** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,205** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, **no** patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,652**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**43**), 20-29 (**149**), 30-39 years (**410**), 40-49 years (**647**), 50-59 years (**1,029**), 60 years and above (**3,312**).

There are **133** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **3,956** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **5** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of whom **4** are on ventilatory support while **1** is on supplemental oxygen. Another **24** are in the General Wards and are all on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

## **VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:**

As of June 29<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **18,815,675** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **16,762,178** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,539,215** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **42,684** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **471,598** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **21,306** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,043**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **31.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
