UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 30, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **49** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,836** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.7%**. From the cases, **45** are Kenyans while **4** are foreigners. **37** are males while **12** are females. The youngest is a

3-year-old while the oldest is **78** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,599** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,819,910**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **24**, Nakuru **13**, Kericho **4**, Kiambu **2**, Machakos **2**, Kirinyaga, Kwale, Narok and Uasin Gishu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(3)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(11)**, 30-39 **(13)**, 40-49 **(6)** 50-59 **(6)**, 60 years and above **(9)**.

Today, **101** patients have recovered from the disease, **99** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **2** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,335** of whom **277,798** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,537** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **53** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **539** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **No** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Another **13** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 29th 2022, a total of **20,350,479** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,404,180** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,792,989** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **230,334** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **922,976** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **147,239** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **41,347**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **33.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
