UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT JULY 31, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **23** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,962** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.2%**. From the cases, **17** are Kenyans while **6** are foreigners. **16** are males while **7** are females. The youngest is a **4-**

year-old while the oldest is **93** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,622** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,821,872**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **16**, Uasin Gishu **3**, Kericho and Siaya **2** cases each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(8)**, 40-49 **(5)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **80** patients have recovered from the disease, **77** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **3** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,415** of whom **277,875** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,540** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **57** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **455** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on supplemental oxygen. Another **12** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 30th 2022, a total of **20,493,898** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,454,531** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,820,705** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **258,639** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **960,023** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **118,543** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **35,108**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **33.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
