PRESS STATEMENT

Today, 17 people have tested positive from a sample size of 944 tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at 1.8 %. All the nine positive **cases** are Kenyans. 11 are male while 6 are female. The youngest is aged 2 **years** while the oldest is **51** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,938** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,837,448**

In terms of **County** distribution, 12 cases are from Nairobi with Nakuru recording 5 cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(5)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(3)**, 30-39 **(4)**, 40-49 **(1)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **45** patients have recovered from the disease, all from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,064** of whom ^{278,482} are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while ^{53,582} are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,673**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,321)**.

There are **40** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **161** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **7** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **7** are in General Wards.

VACCINATION:

As of August 12th, 2022, a total of **20,900,169** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,610,320** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional 1,885,172 are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, 326,326 are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,067,015** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is 4,797 **while** the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at 1,912. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
