UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT AUGUST 1, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **17** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,146** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.5%**. From the cases, **9** are Kenyans while **8** are foreigners. **13** are males while **4** are females. The youngest is a

18-year-old while the oldest is **55** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,639** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,823,018**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **12**, Kajiado **2**, Mandera **2** and Nyeri **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(5)**, 40-49 **(4)** 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **76** patients have recovered from the disease, **71** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **5** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,491** of whom **277,946** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,545** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **57** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **419** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on supplemental oxygen. Another **13** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of July 31st 2022, a total of **20,635,664** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,508,683** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,843,898** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **281,722** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,001,361** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **116,447** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **36,956**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
