UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT AUGUST 3, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **45** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,815** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **2.5%**. From the cases, **40** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **25** are males while **20** are females. The youngest is a

12-year-old while the oldest is **71** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,734** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,826,417**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **19**, Turkana **12**, Nakuru **6**, Busia **2**, Kiambu **2**, Tharaka Nithi **2**, Laikipia and Meru **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(6)**, 20-29 years **(9)**, 30-39 **(14)**, 40-49 **(6)** 50-59 **(6)**, 60 years and above **(3)**.

Today, **55** patients have recovered from the disease, **48** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **7** are from various health facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,627** of whom **278,062** are from the Home-Based Care and

Isolation program, while **53,565** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **44** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **391** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and is on supplemental oxygen. Another **10** are in the General Wards and are **all** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Unit (HDU).

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of August 2nd 2022, a total of **20,749,002** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,553,390** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,864,133** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **303,381** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,028,098** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **24,983** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **8,220**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.1%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
