UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT AUGUST 6, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **25** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,495** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.7%**. From the cases, **23** are Kenyans while **2** are foreigners. **17** are males while **8** are females. The youngest is a

6-year-old infant while the oldest is **81** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,833** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,831,331**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **11**, Nakuru **8**, Siaya **4**, and Murang'a **2** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(5)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(5)**, 40-49 **(2)** 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(5)**.

Today, **67** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,786** of whom **278,220** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,566** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **45** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **330** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **11** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **10** are in General Wards.

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of August 5th 2022, a total of **20,849,975** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,599,298** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,877,768** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **317,382** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,055,527** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **16,769** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **6,509**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.2%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
