UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE MEASURES, AS AT AUGUST 7, 2022

PRESS STATEMENT

Today **20** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,244** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.6%**. From the cases, **12** are Kenyans while **8** are foreigners. **15** are males while **5** are females. The youngest is a

3-year-old infant while the oldest is **68** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **337,853** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,832,575**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **16**, Kiambu, Mombasa, Siaya and Uasin Gishu **1** case each. 1

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(3)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(5)**, 40-49 **(2)** 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(4)**.

Today, **44** patients have recovered from the disease, **38** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **6** are from various facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,830** of whom **278,258** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,572** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **42** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **309** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **11** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **10** are in General Wards.

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of August 6th 2022, a total of **20,857,992** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,602,521** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,879,014** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **319,356** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,057,101** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **3,700** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **1,054**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
